The chaperones will be responsible for carpooling the singers from the First Baptist Church parking lot to the Aquarium at 8:00 a.m., remaining with the girls

throughout the day's activities, then at 1:00 p.m. transporting the girls back to FBC for parent pick-up. **Please call the Girls Choir office by Thursday, Apr. 21 if you are available to serve as a chaperone.**

Vehicles providing carpool services can drop off and park in the lot directly in front of the Aquarium. Drivers please identify yourselves to the parking attendant as Girls Choir.

(Families driving private vehicles may park there or in any nearby parking lot and will be charged regular parking fees.)

TICKETING PROCEDURES

Additional parents, siblings or relatives may tour Ocean Journey with their child's group participating in the Grand Opening following these procedures:

- Call the Aquarium Reservations Department at 423-265-0698 make an advanced ticket reservation by April 25 or earlier if possible.
- Register under the name of your child's group—Chattanooga Girls Choir
- Use the special Aquarium code "**PARADE**" to receive the special price of \$9.75/Adult (age 12 and older) and \$4.25/Child (under age 12).
- If you do not use the code word, the reservationists will automatically charge regular Aquarium admission of \$17.95/Adult; \$9.50/Child.
- Reservationists will provide a confirmation number which must be used to claim Aquarium tickets for admission.
- Tickets may be claimed before or on April 29 at Riverplace, the Aquarium's ticketing center located in the Visitor Center on the plaza. Riverplace is open daily from 9:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Special prices will also be available the morning of April 29 at Riverplace to those using the code word "PARADE" and the name of the school group.
