Novellina (3rd grade) choir- Order forms for the white dress shirt are attached to the High Notes. Please fill out the order form and return it to the rehearsal desk with either check or cash for the amount of the shirt. The due date is Monday, February 25th. We hope to have the shirts delivered by the middle of March.

Fundraising- **Cantilena & Novelina Choir**

Attached to the High Notes today is the Flower Bulb Sales packet. Inside are the product information and sales forms. The due date for completed forms and checks (made out to the Chattanooga Girls Choir) is Monday, February 11th. The flower bulbs are expected to arrive at the end of March. The company ships the orders according to the recommended spring planting season in Tennessee.

The choir hopes to net \$1,000 from this fundraiser-approximately \$35 worth of product sold per family. Money from this fundraiser goes towards specialty programs such as choir appreciation gifts/parties, and entry fees/music purchases for adjudicated performances (such as SECKE).

Spring Auction (all choirs)

If you are interested in volunteering your time to secure donations for the spring auction, please inquire at the rehearsal desk about how you can help. The choir needs your help contacting local businesses for donations!!!

Audition Changes- The CGC Board of directors have made a few changes to the audition process that will affect returning members.

- 1- Members will have to re-audition each year for vocal changes to be addressed and to secure a position in the choir.
- 2- The deposit fee has been broken down into two installments and now represents:
 - an audition fee of \$20 due at the time of audition
 - an \$80 deposit fee due July 1st.

The original \$100 fee has been broken down in this manner to make the maintenance of the music library, maintaining the records, the repair and cleaning of uniforms, billing services, storage, rent, utilities, and other activities necessary to run a successful large organization flow smoother.

- 3- There is now a cap on the number of members accepted per choir. The choir can accommodate up to 45 girls per choir for a total of 180, 4th through 12th graders.
- 4- As there is limit to the number of members per choir, the \$80 deposit needs to be paid no later than July 1st to reserve your membership. If made the deposit is made later than July 1st, your membership will need to be approved by the Executive Director. Also a \$20 late fee will be applied to your account to accommodate the additional ordering of music and work that needs to be done prior to the first day of choir.

One way to complete volunteer hours is to chair/co-chair one of the CGC Parent Support Organization (PSO) Committees. At the end of this year, the PSO will be seeking committee chairs/co-chairs for the following committees for the 2008-2009 season:

- **Secretary** - Takes minutes at the PSO meetings (2 to 4 meetings per year). Meetings generally last only 1 hour.
- **Wardrobe** Need two co-chairs. The position includes keeping an inventory of wardrobe items, fittings, working with chaperones and volunteers (for hemming/washing).
- **Riser Crew** – Position includes organizing parent volunteers to transport, and set up risers for different concerts and events throughout the year.
- **Fundraising**- Fundraising projects are handled through the choir office. This position includes organizing the fundraising committee meetings and keeping the committee on track with its goals.
